Today, there is a Second Collection at the end of Mass, the proceeds of which will go to the Catholic Education Service. Those with the right to use gift aid envelopes, don't forget to do so. The next item will show the importance of it.

On behalf of CAFOD and the suffering people of Haiti, thank you and well done with last Sunday's second collection. We are a small parish, but you gave over £850. That means that with the help of gift aid, the cheque being sent amounts to £1,025. Always remember your gift aid envelope!

The Feast of the Lord's Presentation in the Temple is on Tuesday 2nd February. There is a Mass in Lymington and a Communion Service here at 9.30am.

Communion Services' Future. Fr Jamie and the Liturgy Group have decided to continue the Communion Services throughout the Season of Lent. This is because many of us usually make some extra effort somewhere during Lent. These Services will come to an end on Thursday 25th March, just before Holy Week. After Easter, only one day each week, probably Tuesday, will have a Communion Service for a while. When the liturgy group meets and reflects on the numbers attending, a further decision will be made.

Communion to Forest Oaks. This happens on Sundays, from 11am. At present, three Lay Ministers take it in turn to give Holy Communion there. We are looking for a fourth Lay Minister to join us please, so that each Minister fulfils this duty only once each month. If any existing Minister of Communion is willing to help with this, please tell Paddy Lark.

Ash Wednesday - February 15th. There is a list on the notice board awaiting your signature, concerning Lenten House Groups and what time of the day you would like to attend: 10am, 2pm or 7.30pm. Material for these groups has been designed by the Diocesan Pastoral Team. Not so many years ago, there were always three full groups. In recent times, we have only managed one group. What will happen this year? Please sign the list as soon as you can. Thank you. If you can, put your name to more than one time, indicating which is your first choice.
